Differential Ability Scales including pictures recalled two or three times Recall of Objects-Delayed: trying to recall the pictures again on a surprise retest 15 to 20 minutes later Speed of Information Processing: the student scans rows of figures or numbers and marks the figure with the most parts or the greatest number in each row The score is based on speed
