Patellofemoral Pain syndrome - A general category of anterior knee pain from patella malalignment Also termed anterior knee pain, Patellar malalignment, and Patellofemoral anthralgia

address provision of physical therapy services and patient/client management APTA POSITION ON DOCUMENTATION Documentation Authority For Physical Therapy Services Physical therapy examination, evaluation, diagnosis, prognosis, and plan of care (including interventions) shall be documented, dated, and authenticated by the physical therapist who

Proposed Treatment without Referral Amendments to PT ...

A PT with a BS or MS in Physical Therapy can qualify to treat without a referral by completing 30 CCUs in the area of differential diagnosis Treatment without a referral under this qualifier cannot exceed 10 consecutive business days Do the 30 CCUs in the area of differential diagnosis need to be in 1 ...
